CRT Actions To Date

- Formation of industry COVID-19 Workgroup
- Formal letter to CMS regarding needed changes
- In-person calls with CMS teams; ongoing email exchanges and discussions
- Letters to state Medicaid programs; follow up emails and calls
- Collaboration with advocacy partners: AA Homecare, VGM/US Rehab, State Associations
- Other targeted discussions, calls, and follow up

Big Picture Trends

- Federal/state officials working hard to provide immediate guidance/relief to minimize barriers to care and reduce healthcare system workload
- Common themes: open new pathways for care; minimize/eliminate direct physical contact; reduce burden on healthcare professionals and facilities; relax documentation requirements
- Policy makers processing massive changes; issuing initial guidelines, but acknowledging more will be needed

Impacted CRT Areas

- Wheelchair and seating evals (PT/OT, RTS ATP)
- Deliveries (fitting, adjustments, training)
- Repairs
- New items/Replacements
- Documentation
- Prior Authorizations
- Customer/employee safeguards

Medicare Requests

- Waive face-to-face requirements
- Allow remote technology for clinician and RTS ATP involvement- specialty evaluation, ATP participation, home evaluation
- Allow PTs and OTs to bill under telehealth
- Develop relaxed provisions if urgent need for new/replacement equipment
- Allow repairs without confirmation of continued need by physician

Medicaid/Commercial Requests

- Waive face-to-face requirements
- Allow remote technology for clinician and RTS ATP involvement and home evaluation
- Waive prior authorization for repairs
- For new/replacement CRT modify prior authorization requirement to over \$1,000
- Develop relaxed provisions if urgent need for new/replacement equipment


The CARES Act

- Major legislation signed on March 27 providing national COVID-19 relief
- Authority to expand telehealth
- Business focused loans and relief
- Suspends current 2% Medicare sequester cut from 5/1 to 12/31
- Extends 50/50 blended Medicare rates for rural CB areas; establishes new 75/25 blended rates for all other non-CB areas; through COVID

Interim Rule CMS-1744-IFC Emergency rule focused on COVID-19 Expansion of telehealth "services"- PTs, OTs not in statute as "distant site practitioners" NCD/LCD requirements for in-person services do not apply during COVID-19 PMD Face to Face telehealth restrictions lifted Pausing of DMEPOS prior authorization Waiver of signature on delivery requirement
