INRRTS Releases CRT Supplier Certificate Program

The International Registry of Rehabilitation Technology Suppliers (iNRRTS) has released the first level of the new CRT Supplier Certificate program, a comprehensive education program dedicated to Suppliers of Complex Rehabilitation Technology (CRT).

The program consists of three levels: Level I - Foundational Knowledge of Complex Rehab Technology; Level II - Expanded CRT Content and Specialized Learning; Level III - Practical Demonstration and Skills Assessment where CRT students meet with experienced suppliers.
